Plants Worth Noting - April

Gomesa forbesii (Syn. Oncidium forbesii)

Another plant that I had not seen benched before and I later found that it belonged to Maurie Page. From his critique given towards the end of the night one he has found hard to grow. As a coincidence I had recently purchased a *Gomesa forbesii* only a month or so earlier from Orchid Species Plus

This orchid is native to Brazil and is fairly wide spread, growing in regions such as Rio de Janeiro southward to the state of Santa Catarina. These orchids are thickly spread throughout the upper levels of primary forest from below 2600 ft. (800 m) up to about 5250 ft. (1600 m). Hence why this orchid prefers to grow in cool to warm conditions.

This orchid also prefers high light level at between 2000 foot candles to 3500 foot candles. As Maurie stated he has only had success in growing and flowering this species since he has hung it high in his shadehouse to give it more light.

Orchid Wiz states that plant prefers to grow in shallow well drained containers or mounted on tree fern. If mounted on tree fern it requires high humidity and needs to be watered 2 to 3 times per day particularly in hot dry weather conditions. Orchid can be grown in shallow pots but must be in a well drained mix including medium bark and charcoal with a little bit of chopped sphagnum moss. Plants do not grow well in stale mixes and need to be repotted every 1 to 3 years. More frequently if sphagnum moss is used.

In nature there appears to be two main varieties with one flowering in summer to early autumn and the other flowering in Spring. I note Maurie's flowered in early autumn.

Gomesa forbesii prefers to be grown in a small pot and slightly pot bound. At this stage mine grows in a small pot hung high in the greenhouse with 60% shade. This should equate to 2000fc to 3000fc. Now to make the decision as to whether it stays in this pot for the next year or do I mount it on tree fern.
