Cultural Notes September 18

Den. farmeri

Den. farmeri is an easy orchid to grow if you stick to the basic rules of culture. For most of the so called group of Indian dendrobiums, I do try to keep them in a bright airy spot during the winter with minimal water. Some growers say no water at all, but I have found that a bit hard so if it gets a splash of water when I am watering other plants it does not matter. I do have a sheet of clear plastic roofing on the top of my orchid house to keep the orchid and its roof dry.

Fertilizer is often discussed in what we use etc. Growing conditions are far more important, especially the amount of shade and air movement, with higher humidity in growing season. I do use Duet part A & B Fertilizer weekly in tap water. It must be pointed out

that tap water contains some nutrients, some good and some bad. Using only 25 mls per 100 litres it is very weak but I fertilize every time I water. (it works for me) My *Den. farmeri* is potted every 20 odd years, so maybe I could be forgiven for not remembering what is in the exact mix. Potting is best just after flowering has finished, there is absolutely no room left in the pot for the orchid to keep growing so my choice of weapon will be the axe three good blows should do it.
