General Conditions

- 1. Exhibitor entries are free and open to all members of approved Orchid Societies. A noncompetitive section is available if required.
- 2. Every Exhibitor shall complete the documentation EDOS Inc. is required to keep in respect of 'Fire Ants' legislation.
- 3. Any exhibitor whose plants are ordinarily housed within a 'FIRE ANT Restricted Area', who does not produce current documents allowing his/her plants to be moved to the show venue, shall not be permitted to table their plants, and shall be excluded from competition.
- 4. Entries must be tabled by 7.00 pm & available for judging at 7.30 pm.
- 5. Staking and tying shall be sufficient to support the inflorescence, but shall be unobtrusive and not detract from the display of the bloom. Ties must be removable, i.e. NO TAPE!!
- 6. The Show Captain and/or Chief Steward have the right to:
 - a. Reject, remove or re-arrange any entry;
 - b. Determine the class in which any plant may be entered;
 - c. Combine and/or establish classes if need be.
- 7. Entries must not be removed from the hall or tables until after the presentation of prizes on Sunday without the prior permission of the Show Executive (see C.14).
- 8. A New Grower is defined as one who has not been excluded from the New Growers Section at EDOS Inc. Monthly meetings.
- 9. Any stands tabled must be appropriate to the size of the plants exhibited.
- 10. A specimen plant is defined as a mature plant which has been grown from a single clone, has a large number of flowers and shows evidence of good culture over an extended period of time.
- 11. In class "Seedling –etc Flowering for the first time" an orchid developed from the meristem process will be excluded.
- 12. All plants must be the property of the exhibitor and been in the possession of the exhibitor for the preceding 6 months.
- 13. Where a plant is eligible for more than one class it will be the owner's responsibility to select which class the plants will be judged in.
- 14. EDOS Inc. or its agents or the Brisbane International Shooting Centre or its agents, accept no responsibility for the theft, loss or destruction of plants, or damage of any kind, occasioned to plants either during transport to and from the show venue, or whilst at the show venue.
- 15. The Show Executive (The President, Show Captain & Chief Steward) will be the sole arbiters should matters of dispute arise.
- 16. Individual plants may be entered in one class only.
- 17. The Champion Orchids will be selected from all plants benched on display tables within designated Competition Class Sections, excluding Class 44.
- 18. The Judge's decision is final.
- 19. Acceptance of any entry will be conditional on the exhibitor agreeing to be bound by the conditions set out above.
- 20. Non EDOS Inc Members are eligible to have plants in the plant sales area for sale provided that they have a minimum of two show quality plants benched in the show.
- 21. Plant sales are for Orchids and orchid related products only.
- 22. Bar Code sale Labels are to be requested in advance of the show.
- 23. Prizes are awarded for the first three placings. All orchid entries for exhibiting that do not fit into a designated class shall be accommodated within an appropriate class or a new class.
